
About

The Nice Côte d'Azur Metropolis is an intercommunal structure in France located in the Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur region, around the city of Nice. It stretches from a mountainous rural area in the north to a highly urbanized coastal area in the south, bordering the Mediterranean Sea.
